<p>a white 2016 Hyundai Genesis (V-1) was eastbound on SW 18th Street, east of Barwood Lane, in the unincorporated portion of Boca Raton, Florida. In the area of collision, SW 18th Street is a curved roadway with a posted speed limit of 45 miles per hour. Weather for the area was intermittent rain showers which had been present for multiple days. The roadway was wet and there was limited supplemental lighting in the area of the collision. The limitations for the overhead lighting were as a result of the trees which blocked the casting of the lamps.</p> <p>V-1 was eastbound on Southwest 18th Street, east of Barwood Lane, operating on a wet, poorly lit roadway, while negotiating a left curve at a high rate of speed. While attempting to negotiate the curve the vehicles rear tires broke traction and it began to rotate counterclockwise. D-1 overcorrected while applying corrective steering causing V-1 to rotate clockwise and depart the roadway. V-1 entered the shoulder, slid 121 feet through the wet grass, and the front of V-1 impacted a standing tree. V-1 rotated off the tree clockwise and came to rest facing northwest.</p> <p>The impact was so forceful the steering wheel was torn from the vehicle and ejected, the driver's headrest was ejected, the rear differential had been visibly dislodged from the right axle and the engine shifted into the firewall collapsing the front passenger compartment where Jacob Fajardo (P-1) was seated. Once Fire Rescue extricated Fajardo, he was transported to Delray Medical Center and pronounced deceased from injuries sustained during the collision.</p> <p>A closer inspection of V-1's interior confirmed the presence of two rear seat occupants. Adrianna Moses (P-2) sitting in the left rear based upon the damage to the seat being consistent with the traumatic injuries sustained to her right lower extremities including broken bones. Gianna Loforte (P-3) was identified as sitting in the right rear at the time of collision and had sustained a closed head injury.</p> <p>Witnesses Steven Senra and Jonnathan Nassar heard the collision and came to assist from the parking lot of the nearby residences. Both observed a male exit the driver's side of V-1, walk around for a short time and flee westbound from the scene. Both pursued the driver and guided PBSO to his approximate location. The driver was later identified as Joshua Washington (D-1), and he was transported to Delray Medical Center. D-1 had a puncture wound to his right thigh, a laceration to his head and a possible laceration to his spleen.</p> <p>During a recorded interview Senra indicated that he had observed D-1 exit the driver's side of V-1, walk around the area for a brief time and leave westbound. Senra began to follow D-1 and heard D-1 on the phone. During the call Senra heard D-1 state "Dude come get me I fucked up, I fucked up come get me." Senra continued to follow D-1 while guiding PBSO via telephone to D-1's location.</p>

<p>On the <u>21</u> day of <u>November</u> 20<u>21</u> at <u>9:45</u> <input type="checkbox"/> A.M. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p>								
<p>During a recorded interview with Nassar he indicated that he had observed D-1 exit from the driver's side of V-1, walk around the area for a brief time and leave westbound. Nassar pursued D-1 guiding PBSO via telephone to his approximate location.</p> <p>On November 24th 2021, at approximately 12:30 p.m., I reviewed a set of scaled diagrams from the collision scene. Based on the diagrams I performed a limited mathematical reconstruction of the speed loss for V-1 as it traveled over the shoulder. I determined the minimum speed loss of V-1 through the shoulder was 38 miles per hour. An additional measurement of speed loss at the time of collision was unavailable, as the airbag control module did not record the event due to the system suffering a catastrophic failure as a result of the impact location and severity.</p> <p>On December 8th, 2021, at approximately 9:30 a.m., I reviewed the toxicology report from the admissions blood vials which had been obtained from Delray Medical Center for D-1. Results from the blood samples were:  <b>0.069 +/- 0.006 grams of ethanol per 100 milliliters of blood</b>  <b>0.070 +/- 0.006 grams of ethanol per 100 milliliters of blood</b>  <b>Delta-9-THC at 3.0 +/- 0.9 ng/mL</b></p> <p>Based upon my investigation I determined that Joshua Washington, an unlicensed driver under the influence of alcohol and cannabis, was operating V-1 eastbound on SW 18th Street, unincorporated Boca Raton. D-1 was operating V-1 with three additional occupants upon a wet, poorly lit roadway, while negotiating a left curve at a high rate of speed. V-1 lost control due to D-1's reckless operation and entered a counterclockwise yaw. D-1 attempted to regain control of V-1 by counter steering however oversteered placing the vehicle into a clockwise yaw. V-1 departed the roadway to the south, leading with the front driver's side, angularly traversed the shoulder for approximately 120 feet and impacted a standing tree. V-1 rotated clockwise off of the tree and came to rest facing northwest. Post collision D-1 fled the scene.</p> <p>D-1's reckless actions caused the death of Jacob Fajardo, traumatic injuries to Adrianna Moses causing her to be intubated and scheduled for surgery for broken bones in her lower right extremities, and a closed head injury to Gianna LaForte. Post Collision Washington did or should have knowing that persons were injured and/or deceased in the crash as he was also severely injured including a bleeding head injury, a puncture wound to his right thigh and a potentially lacerated spleen before fleeing the scene.</p>
