White patrolling Glades Park Towers (921 Indian River Street, Boca Raton FL 33431) Parking Lot 21, I observed two white males occupying a Black in color Henda Accord bearing Florida Tag QDDQ63, that had smoke contained inside of the vehicle. I parted my marked patrol vehicle away from the car and approached them on foot. When I arrived at the vehicle, I observed the car filled with smoke and the passenger smoking what appeared to be the a marijuana cigar. With my training knowledge end experience, I could also smell the odor of burnt merijuana emanating from the vehicle. In the drivers lap, I observed a tray with what appeared to be fresh marijuana on it. Due to the observed marijuana and the odor, I started to conduct a criminal imentionition. As the passengers window rolled down, I identified myself as a Police Officer and asked for both the passenger and the driver's ication cards since there was and odor of marifuant coming from the vehicle. The driver was identified by his Florida Driver's License as Sebastian Lee Sargeant and the passenger was identified by name, date of birth and social security number as Matthew D. Payich. Sargeant stepped out of his vehicle when he provided me with his identification and placed a black Louis Vuitton backpack o his dash board. While Sargeant handed me his Florida Driver's License, I observed multiple denominations of bi<mark>lls folded</mark> into bundles, which in my training, knowledge and experience, is an indicator of narcotic sales. Sargeont asked if he could retrieve his Black backpack that was on the dashboard, however, I told him to leave it in the vehicle while I conducted my investigation. When my backup officer arrived on scene I advised Sargeant of his Miranda Warnings prior to any questioning. Sargeant stated that he wanted to invoke his rights at this time. I then asked Payich to edit the vehicle and stand by my car while the vehicle was searched. While searching the interior of the vehicle, I observed a fresh green loafy substance, that is consistent with that of Marijuana. I was able to find 6 black containers labeled as L.A. Hade (states connabis on wanting label), a grinder and 2 jars that appeared to marijuana as well. Both individuals were detained at this time. As I continued my search of the vehicle, I opened the trunk and observed a large black duffel bag containing 7 large jars of a agreen leafly substance, which appeared to be Martjuena. I also observed a digital scale, which is also indicative with the sale of marculates. I then checked a Grey leckpack which contained another jar and 7 plastic began with also containing a green leafly miliatunce consistent with marijuana. While conducting a search of the trunk, Officer Petricone searched the black backpack and located several white her like pills in back to the petric pack and located several white her like pills in a clear plastic bag. Payich stated that he just come to smoke with Sargeant and that they had just met recently. Due to Payich not being involved in the sales and it not being his vehicle, he was released on scene. Due to the totality of the circumstances, I believe probable cause exist that Sargeant did knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver Alprazulam, commonly known as Xanax, a controlled substance, within 1906 fast of the real property comprising a public or private college, university, or other postsecondary educational institution, contrary to Fferida Statute 893.13(1)(d)2. I also believe probable cause exist that Sargeant did knowingly sell, manufacture, district or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver Apphetamine, a controlled substance, on, or within 1800 feet of the real property comprising a public or private college, university, or other postsecondary educational institution, contrary to Fluxible Statute 893.13(1)(d)2. erfluence will be weighed and placed into evidence and Submitted to PBSO for testing.
