The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant committed the following violation of law:

On 02/11/2022, at 01:00 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On the above date and time, I was assigned to uniform road patrol within the jurisdictional limits of Florida Atlantic University Police Department, 777 Glades Road, Boca Raton, Florida 33431, Palm Beach County, Florida.

While patrolling Glades Park Towers (921 Indian River Street, Boca Raton FL 33431) Parking Lot 21, I observed two white males occupying a Black in color Honda Accord bearing Florida Tag QDDQ83, that had smoke contained inside of the vehicle. I parked my marked patrol vehicle away from the car and approached them on foot. When I arrived at the vehicle, I observed the car filled with smoke and the passenger smoking what appeared to be the a marijuana cigar. With my training knowledge and experience, I could also smell the odor of burnt marijuana emanating from the vehicle. In the drivers lap, I observed a tray with what appeared to be fresh marijuana on it. Due to the observed marijuana and the odor, I started to conduct a criminal investigation.

As the passengers window rolled down, I identified myself as a Police Officer and asked for both the passenger and the driver's identification cards since there was an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The driver was identified by his Florida Driver's License as Sebastian Lee Sargeant and the passenger was identified by name, date of birth and social security number as Matthew D. Payich.

Sargeant stepped out of his vehicle when he provided me with his identification and placed a black Louis Vuitton backpack on his dash board. While Sargeant handed me his Florida Driver's License, I observed multiple denominations of bills folded into bundles, which in my training, knowledge and experience, is an indicator of narcotic sales. Sargeant asked if he could retrieve his Black backpack that was on the dashboard, however, I told him to leave it in the vehicle while I conducted my investigation. When my backup officer arrived on scene I advised Sargeant of his Miranda Warnings prior to any questioning. Sargeant stated that he wanted to invoke his rights at this time. I then asked Payich to exit the vehicle and stand by my car while the vehicle was searched. While searching the interior of the vehicle, I observed a fresh green leafy substance, that is consistent with that of Marijuana. I was able to find 6 black containers labeled as L.A. Made (states cannabis on warning label), a grinder and 2 jars that appeared to marijuana as well. Both individuals were detained at this time.

As I continued my search of the vehicle, I opened the trunk and observed a large black duffel bag containing 7 large jars of a green leafy substance, which appeared to be Marijuana. I also observed a digital scale, which is also indicative with the sale of narcotics. I then checked a Gray backpack which contained another jar and 7 plastic bags with also containing a green leafy substance consistent with marijuana.

While conducting a search of the trunk, Officer Patricone searched the black backpack and located several white bar like pills mixed in with several round peach colored pills in a clear plastic bag. The bars were later identified using the numbers and letter and cross referencing them with Drugs.com as Alprazolam (Xanax) and the peach colored pills were identified as Adderall using the same resources. At this time, I advised Sargeant that he was under arrest for the possession of Schedule 4 and Schedule 2 drugs with intent to distribute. It should be noted that there were 7 empty sandwich bags located that are also typically used for the sale of illegal narcotics. There were no prescription bottles located in the car for either substance.

I then read Payich his Miranda Rights, to which he stated that he understood them. Payich stated that he just come to smoke with Sargeant and that they had just met recently. Due to Payich not being involved in the sales and it not being his vehicle, he was released on scene.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I believe probable cause exist that Sargeant did knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver Alprazolam, commonly known as Xanax, a controlled substance, within 1000 feet of the real property comprising a public or private college, university, or other postsecondary educational institution, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(1)(d)2. I also believe probable cause exist that Sargeant did knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver Amphetamine, a controlled substance, on, or within 1000 feet of the real property comprising a public or private college, university, or other postsecondary educational institution, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(1)(d)2.

The marijuana will be weighed and placed into evidence and Submitted to PBSO for testing.
