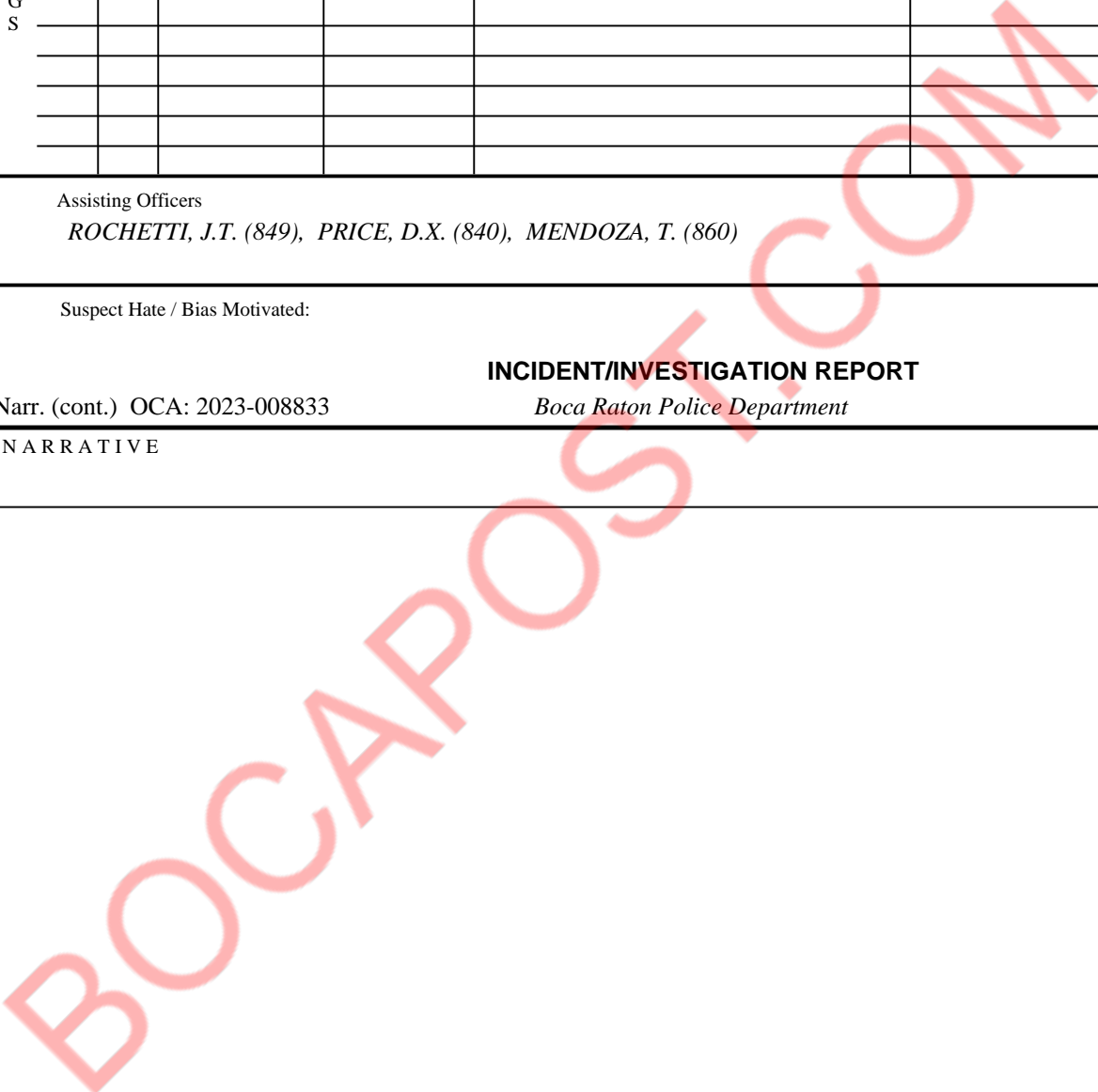

On 07/13/2023 at approximately 2016 hours, I responded to 399 E Camino Real. in reference to a welfare check. Prior to arrival, the caller, Gary Swid, requested officers make contact with his 23-year-old-daughter, Bayla Swid, because he believed his daughter was being held against her will and has maxed out all her credit cards.

Upon arrival, contact was made with Gary who was concerned about Bayla because she was not answering his calls and had maxed out her credit cards. He believed her current boyfriend who he does not know is the cause for this. Aside from Bayla being secretive about her boyfriend there was no other indication to suggest that she was being held against her will or in need of police services.

Through Baylas location sharing from her cellphone, officers were able to make contact with her at the Flamingo Grill. Bayla was sitting at the bar area and agreed to speak with officers outside. She explained she was having drinks with her boyfriend and did not need any assistance from officers. She did not show any signs of distress or concern and told officers she was fine and comfortable adding that she was an adult and can do whatever she wants. Officers did not notice anything suspicious while talking to her. She also told officers that she was going to obtain a restraining order against her father.

Gary was informed of the outcome.
